Supplies you will need:





Decorations: Some décor for the ribbon.

We're all set to put our arrangement together!

STEP 1: Slide the foam bar into the bag, then put the glass beads inside for added weight and to make the arrangement steady. (I doubled up on the bags to make sure it was water proof.)



STEP 2: Cut Gerbera approx. 6 1/2" in length and insert into top of foam leaving approximately 6" showing.



STEP 3: Cut Carnation stems to 1 ¼" in length. Add your three Carnations to the base of the vase leaving one end open.



STEP 4: Cut Eucalyptus sprig to extend 1 ½" to 2" higher than Gerbera and insert into foam next to Gerbera in open area. Fill in with lemon leaves or Leatherleaf fern.



STEP 5: Add your Baby's Breath/Gyp. Tie a ribbon and add a small decoration if desired.
