This is a very basic line design arrangement. It would be a good design to use for almost any occasion. So if you're ready, let's get started!

Supplies you will need:

Flowers:

3 – Fuji Mums (Color choice is up to you.)



4 - Delphinium stalks or filler stalks of your choice



2 – Bunches of Mini-Mums



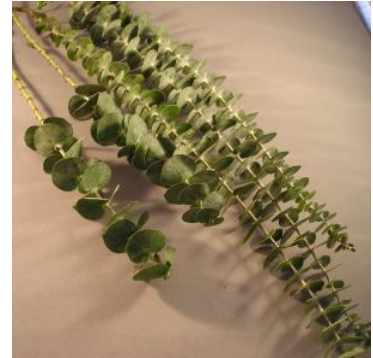

2 – Large Mums (Choice of color is up to you)



4 – Eucalyptus branches.



The rest of Your Supplies:

1 – Round Bowl (approx. 6" diameter)



1 – Block of Wet foam



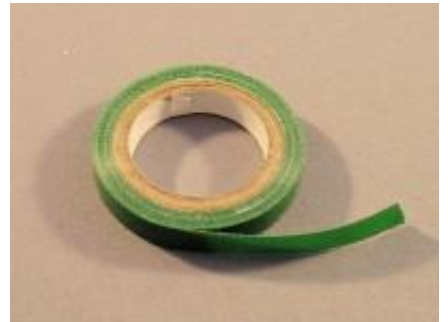

Some moss to cover the foam in bowl.



Some waterproof florists tape to hold the foam inside the bowl to increase its stability and help keep the flowers from moving.



Some florist pins to hold the moss on the foam block.



3 - Artificial butterflies to add additional color to arrangement. (Optional)

We're all set to put our arrangement together!

STEP 1: Cut foam to fit bowl. It should be approximately 1" higher than the rim of the bowl. Soak the foam thoroughly.



STEP 2: Using the florist tape, tape the foam down to the bowl. This will help to insure that the flowers will not move.



STEP 3: Using your florists pins, attach the moss sparingly to the foam. Be sure to let the moss hang over the sides a bit, covering the tape.

STEP 4: Cut 2 stalks of your Eucalyptus approx. 20" in length and place them at the back of the arrangement. Cut the other 2 stalks approx. 18" and place them at the front of the arrangement inserting them through the side of the foam block.



STEP 5: Cut 1 Delphinium stalk approx. 16", cut 3 stalks 14" in length. Take the 16" stalk and with 1 of the 14" stalks on each side, place them in front of the rear Eucalyptus branches. We will use the 4th stalk in just a moment.



STEP 6: Cut the Mini-Mums from the bunch and leave each stem approx. 6" in length. Place 5 at the in front of the Delphiniums and three inserted in the sides above the Eucalyptus. We will use leftover minis as fillers later.

STEP 7: Cut the large mums to lengths of 7" and 6". Insert them into the middle of the arrangement with the shorter one in front.



STEP 8: Now cut 1 Fuji Mum 7" in length and the other 2 to 5" lengths. Place one of each 5" flower on each side of the Large Mums towards the front and the 7" Fuji toward the back side of the Large Mums as pictured.

Step 9: Take the remaining Delphinium and place it between the two front Eucalyptus. Use any of the remaining mini-mums to fill in any gaps that may be left on the side of the arrangement.



STEP 10: Place the three butterflies around the arrangement similar to the picture on the right.
